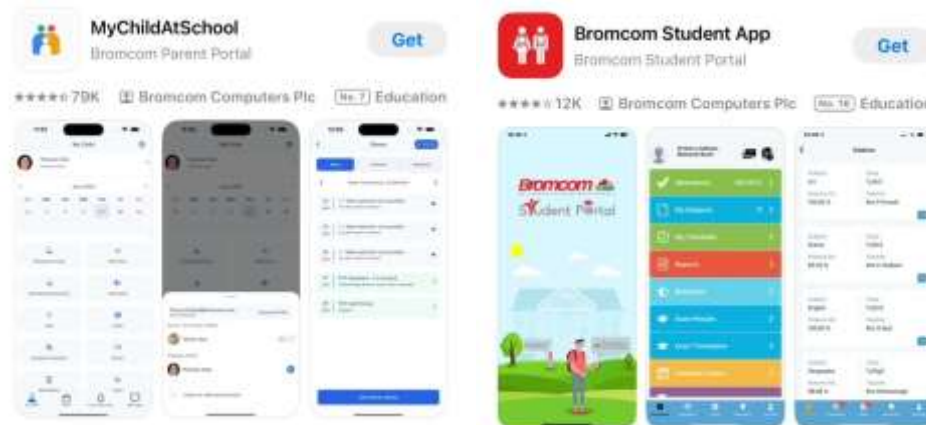
Crispin Communications
