Dear Parents, Carers and students

As we begin the GCSE Options process for Year 9 students, I am writing to outline the process, key dates, and the support available to you and your child as they make these important decisions. While all students will continue to study a core set of compulsory subjects in Upper School, they will also have the opportunity to choose four additional option subjects as part of their GCSE pathway.

We recognise that this is a significant and sometimes daunting stage, and our aim is to ensure that students are supported to make thoughtful, well-informed choices that reflect their strengths, interests, and future aspirations.

Year 9 Options Evening - Monday 2 February 2026

We warmly invite you to attend our in-person Year 9 Options Evening, which will run as follows:

- **6:00 pm – Presentation for families with student surnames A-L**
- **6:30 pm – Presentation for families with student surnames M-Z**

Both presentations will be led by me and will cover the same information, including how the options process works, how subjects are allocated, and key points to consider when making choices.

While one presentation is taking place, families are encouraged to visit subject areas around the school. Teachers will be available throughout the evening to discuss course content, expectations, and progression routes, including subjects that are newly available at GCSE.
